

**FUNERALS**: Funerals are coordinated between the Funeral Home and the parish. The process:

- 1. The family gets in touch with the Funeral Home.
- 2. The Funeral Home checks their schedule, and then gets in touch with the parish office.
- 3. The parish staff check on the availability of the priest and the church building.
- 4. The parish confirms with the funeral home, and the funeral home confirms with the family.
